Overview

Te Whānau Hou Grovetown Lagoon Restoration Project

Te Whānau Hou Grovetown Lagoon Restoration Project is led and managed by Te Whānau Hou Grovetown Lagoon Executive Committee, and Te Whānau Hou Grovetown Lagoon Working Group. The Executive Committee and the Working Group have different responsibilities, these being governance (the Executive Committee) and implementation (the Working Group).

It is the Working Group which implements, while the Executive has more of a monitoring and strategic role. The Working Group reports back to the Executive with progress as they implement projects, and the Executive responds to the Working Group's needs.

The Executive meets several times a year, while the Working Group meet every 6 weeks. The Grovetown Lagoon Executive is made up of 8 members. 5 members are appointed and 3 are elected. One Executive Committee member is appointed by each Foundation member. The Foundation members of Te Whānau Hou are:
