

## **Meeting Summary**

## **Trustees Present**

- Approved the minutes of the Trust hui held on 16 February 2023 and received an update on actions arising from the hui
- Approved the appointment of accounting services provider Wallace Diack for the Rangitāne Group.
- Approved annual review and reappointment of Kaikōkiri positions. Noted the existing mandates held on behalf of Rangitāne.
- Approved the establishment of a Kaikōkiri Toi Māori role, from 1 July 2023.
- Approved new Trustee remuneration rates from July 2023. The new remuneration rates, on an annual basis, will be as follows:
  - Chairperson, \$30,000
  - Deputy Chairperson, \$21,174
  - Trustee, \$21,174
- Approved 20 membership applications (February-March) on the advice of the Whakapapa Komiti
- Received a report on the progress of co-governance options for Te Pokohiwi o Kupe, and an update on the Conservation Management Plan
- Received an update from the Kaiwhakahaere Matua on Organisational Management including:
